

Journal of the Whaling Brig Eunice
Sunday September 17th 1893
In port Wind Northeast and the weather
squally with light rain The whole day

Monday 18th
Two of the crew Alexander Allen and Thomas
Evans deserted from the vessel. Fine weather
all the day Wind to the eastward

Tuesday 19th
Received on board a lighter load of whaling
supplies from the Bark Sarah Four more
of the crew went ashore on leave and up to
the ending of the day has not returned
Fine weather all day Wind southeast

Wednesday 20th
The four men has not returned and as their
time is up they have also deserted the vessel.
Their names are Alfred Ducam Moses Francis
John Francis. Will Webb. Mine today whaling for
H. Hodydon with one hundred and thirty barrels

Thursday 21st
In port Fair weather all the day Two coopers
came on board and commenced to set up
the shoals. Wind northeast Had

Friday 22nd
The balance of the crew helping the coopers
Weather squally with light showers
of rain Wind to the southward

Saturday 23th
The men cleaning shoals and stowing
the hole Weather squally wind southwest (faint)
The American Consul paid a visit to the ship and

Sunday September 24th 1893
Fine weather all the day with the wind
to the southeast The balance of the crew
ashore on leave

Monday 25th
The coopers to work all day setting up the
casks and the crew stowing the hole
and putting the floor in casks Wind
east and the weather squally The first
part of the day but fair towards the
latter

Tuesday 26th
The coopers to work all the day
making casks Two more of the crew
went ashore last night and has not
returned Their names are
Fine weather all the day

Wednesday 27th
The coopers working same as yesterday. The
two men has not returned and as their
time is up they have deserted the vessel.
Received a lighter load of wood from
the shore also got four casks of water
Fine weather the first part of the day but
a light rain towards the latter

Thursday 28th
The coopers finished setting up the casks
and went ashore fetching water all the
day Hired two men from the shore to help get
the vessel ready for sea Fine weather all the
day

Friday 29th
Getting water and stowing the hole, Weather
fine and the wind from the southeast
