tack by the wind under easy sail.

This day still blowing
from the eastward vessel close hauled
on port tack under storm sails.

Long 17-59

Friday Oct. 27th

This day very strong
breeze from the eastward vessel
hove too on the starboard tack.
under easy sail,
Lat. 35-25
