

Harbor master came alongside and we told him what was the matter that our captain was crazy and he said he would send the doctor to look after him accordingly he did so and the doctor came to see him and the mate and doctor went to the council and the council came of to see him saying to keep a sharp lookout on him that he would take him to the hospital next day. The mate stated our condition to the council tell him we was short of grub and he gave us an agent named de Costa and he gave us a half barrel of potatoes, and one hundred pounds of sweet potatoes, fifteen pounds of beef three heads of cabbage and little bundle of unions and ten pounds of sugar.

Tuesday 20th March

This day the council came to see the captain again and found he was worse he said he would go ashore and send for him and we dressed him and waited on the council and he went ashore about ten o'clock and reached the hospital at one, and about two the council came on board packed away his things and sealed his room.

Wednesday 21st March

This day clear, Easterly trades two whaling schooners left here for Dominica. Charles H. Hodgdon, & Adelia, Chase.

Thursday 22nd March

This day clear, Easterly trades Whaling Schooner Ada, Bobson, Captain & Mr. arrived with forty barrels of sperm oil.

Prakes out the hole

Friday 23rd March

This day clear Easterly trades the schooner Ida Bobson sailed for Dominica

Monday 26th March

This day Easterly trades broke the hole 1 barrel of beef and painted two coats.

Tuesday 27th March

This day Easterly trades The schooner Pedro Va. Pilla sail for Dominica and we were mending the foresail.

Friday 30th March

This day clear weather we finished mending the foresail, started on ~~all~~ the topsail and flying jib sewed them and bended them on.

Sunday 1st April

This day clear weather the captain arrived Captain John Goncalves master.

Wednesday 4th April

This day clear weather took out the broken pot and sent it ashore to be mended, and one of the ship's pumps and two hand pumps to be repaired. and broke out forty-nine barrels and thirty gallons of oil

Thursday 5th April

This day clear weather scrubbed the vessel outside and stowed the things below.
