This twenty four hours commenced with calm weather saw a lot of whales around unbanded the foresail and mended it and banded it on after dinner done ships duty gained the Golden City after dinner end this day.

Saturday 28th

This twenty four hours commenced with light breeze broke out the hole for bread, water, and a keg of molasses. scrubbed the ship but did not raise a school of whales about half past four lowered but being too calm the sun set before we got to them. mated with the Golden City got aboard eight o'clock end this day.
