Tuesday 31st This twenty four hours commenced with light breeze vessel under all sail half of the day later part a squall with rain and wind took in the mainsail. Wind S.W. done ships duty end this day.

Wednesday 1st Sept This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather from the South gained the hedgesons done ships duty end this day. Lat 36.55

Thursday 2nd Sept This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather saw the schooners chasing a large whale and we went down and struck him.

Starboard came aboard put up the gear and started to cut in never got through and this day. Lat 36.50

Friday 3rd This twenty four hours commenced cutting again and got him in and started the work. Lost the case end this day. Lat 36.30

Saturday 4th This twenty four hours commenced with rain and strong breeze continued trying but lost a great deal of oil stored down three casks end this day. Lat 36.55

Sunday 5th This twenty four hours commenced with rain but the fire under the pots and had to wait until the rain had ceased stopped about twelve o'clock and started trying again and got through end this day. Lat

Monday 6th This twenty four hours commenced with rain but ceased about mid day broke out two barrels flour and one barrel of meat. stored down more oil that day end this day. Lat 37.10
