Light wind from S W were several

Saw some sailing the N. C. Parker
one Whaling schooner came aboard
and spoke us Capt. Arthur Edwards
Lat 32.06 Lon 52.03

Tue July 11
Saw some from East spoke schooner
and spoke us nothing more

Fri July 12
Still a bit breeze from N E spoke Capt.
Lester Hunter Schooner 5. Mouthout 80
Lat 31.36 Lon 53.56

Sat July 13
Light wind from E saw some small
ship caught some fish
Lat 31.47 Lon 54.25

Sun July 14
Sailing by saw nothing
Lat 32.24 Lon 54.32

Mon July 15
More sail and stood to sea saw
nothing
Lat 32.12 Lon 56.18

Tue July 16
Sailing the West all day saw
nothing
Lat 32.48 Lon 57.54
