

Towards Western Islands

Monday July 3. 1849.

Commenced fine breeze from N.W. Steering E.S.E. under all sail. Middle and latter part light winds from N.W. Steering E.S.E. under all sail. Saw three ships. Lat 38.00 Long 34.58

Tuesday July 4

Commenced with fine breeze from N.W. Steering E.S. under all sail. at 6 P.M. tacked ship stood to the westward under short sail at one tacked stood E.S.E. latter part light winds and Calms steering E.S.E. saw one brig steering East to land. Lat 38.26 Long 34.48

Wednesday July 5

Commenced with light winds & calms. Middle part the same. latter part light winds from Northward Steering E.S. under all sail. Saw three ships. Lat 38.34 Long 35.57

Thursday July 6

Commenced with light winds from Northward Steering E.S.E. under all sail at 6 P.M. took in sail middle part calms. at 4 P.M. made all sail stood E.S.E. latter part fine breeze from N.W. Steering E.S.E. under all sail. Saw three ships. Lat 38.42 Long 37.34

Friday July 7

Commenced with fine breeze from N.W. Steering E.S.E. under all sail at 6 P.M. took in sail middle part strong & squally headed E.S.E. under double reefed topsails. latter part strong winds from N.W. Steering E.S.E. under double reefed topsails. Saw three ships. Lat 38.58 Long 38.32

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Saturday July 8. 1849

Commenced with fine breeze from N.W. Steering N.E. under all sail. Saw one bark steering E.S.E. at 7 P.M. took in sail middle part strong breeze from N.W. at 4 P.M. made sail steering S.E. latter part good weather Steering S.E. under all sail. Saw 2 ships. Saw three ships. Lat 39.17 Long 38.52

Sunday July 9

Commenced with fine breeze from Northward Steering S.E. under all sail at 7 P.M. took in sail middle part good weather steering E.S.E. at 4 P.M. made all sail stood S.E. Saw 2 ships. latter part fine breeze from N.E. steering S.E. under all sail. Saw three ships. Lat 38.25 Long 32.32

Monday July 10

Commenced with fine breeze from N.E. Steering S.E. under all sail. 2 ships in sight at 6 P.M. took in sail middle part light winds steering S.E. at 4 P.M. made all sail stood S.E. Steering S.E. under all sail. Saw three ships. Lat 39.12 Long 32.35

Tuesday July 11

Commenced with fine breeze from Eastward Steering N.E. under all sail. Saw one bark at 7 P.M. took in sail middle part good weather at 4 P.M. made all sail stood S.E. Saw three ships. Lat 39.12 Long 32.35

Wednesday July 12

Commenced with fine breeze from E.S.E. Steering S.E. under all sail. Saw one brig at 7 P.M. took in sail middle part good weather at 4 P.M. made all sail Steering Eastward latter part calms. Saw three ships. Lat 39.45 Long 30.11
