

Cruising of the Islands

Sunday July 22 1847

Commence with light winds and calms
lying of St Georges middle part light winds steering
for Terceira latter part calms & ends to obs

Monday July 23

Commence with light winds & calms
steering down by Terceira one brig in sight
middle part strong winds from Nth steering
of and on Terceira latter part thick & rainy
Lat 34. Long nothing

Tuesday July 24

Commence with strong Breeze from
N.W. steering of and on Terceira spoke the ship
Herald of war Bury 2 middle part strong Breeze
from N.W. steering of and on Terceira under double reefed sail
latter part strong winds steering for St Georges under double reefed sail
to ends N.W. Long nothing

Wednesday July 25

Commence with fine Breeze from North
steering by St Georges middle part light winds
and squally & rainy steering down by Fayal & Pico
saw the Bank S.E. Donnell at anchor with 250 lbs
spin oil to ends these 24 hours to obs

Thursday July 26

Commence with strong Breeze
from North steering down by Pico under white
topsail at 7 P.M. double reefed sails steering S.E.
middle part the same latter part
fine winds from N.W. and good weather steering
S.E. all hands employed in ship duty to ends

Cruising of the Islands

Friday July 27 1847

Commence with light winds & calms
Islands in sight middle part light winds steering
for Terceira latter part light winds & calms to ends
to obs

Saturday July 28

Commence with light winds & calms
at 4 P.M. one boat went on shore at Terceira at 7 P.M.
come on board middle part calms steering of & on
latter part light winds one boat on shore to ends
No obs

Sunday July 29

Commence fine weather steering down
Terceira one boat on shore at 6 P.M. come on board
steering Easter under all sail middle part calms
latter part light winds & calms steering of & on
Terceira saw Blackfish towed got one to ends

Monday July 30

Commence fine weather steering S.E.
under all sail Terceira in sight middle & latter
part light winds and calms steering S.E. for
St Michael saw Black fish saw 2 ships to ends

Tuesday July 31

Commence with light winds & calms
St Michael in sight middle part calms spoke
the Ship Rodericus two boats nothing latter part
light winds & calms St Michael in sight dist 20 miles
to ends to obs
