Commence light wind & calm

foretop sail. Middle part fine Brees from NW
Steering SW under all sail latter part the same

from NW steering SW under double reefed sails.
Middle part strong gales from NW steering
going too under close reefed main topsail
Latter part more moderate so that the ship

Commence with light wind from
NW with a strong breeze on headed the ship
under double reefed topsails. Middle part calms
Latter part strong winds from NW steering
SW under reefed sails. Lat 37.45 Long 17.45

Monday Oct 1

Commence with strong winds from
NW steering SE under double reefed sails.
Middle part the same Latter part strong
winds from NW going to headed to the SW. Brees

Tuesday Oct 2

Commence with fine Brees
from NW steering SE under reefed topsails
Middle part light winds from NW steering SE
at 6 o'clock made Tristan da Cunha Dist. 50 Miles
Latter part light winds from NW steering
SE under all sail. Saw five birds so that

Wednesday Oct 3 1849

Commence with fine Brees from
North steering down by the Head. under all sail
Middle part gave Weather going off to the S. Brees
Latter part fine Weather standing off to the S. spoke
the Barge & arrived at harbour 13 months out. 1000 lbs

Thursday Oct 4

Commence fine Weather going off to
in company with the ship on same fine Brees
Middle part fine Weather strong Ely under short
sail in company with the ship Latter part light
winds from SE & rain & thick so that there 24 hours

Friday Oct 5

Commence with light winds from SE
and thick and rain. Brees in sight at 7 PM
double reefed topsails. Middle part gave Weather Latter
part fine Weather steering Ely under all sail
one ship in sight so that there 24 hours

Lat 36.35 Long 10.44

Saturday Oct 6

Commence with light winds from
North steering Ely under all sail at 6 PM
double reefed topsails steering to Ely. Middle part sailing
Latter part fine Weather steering Ely under
all sail so that there 24 hours

Lat 36.17 Long 7.40

Sunday Oct 7

Commence with light winds from
South steering East. Middle part light winds
and calms. Latter part fine Brees from
North steering South under all sail saw
plenty of fine birds so that there 24 hours

Lat 37.30 Long 7.20
