Latter strong wind employed stowing down
Saw Whales Saw one ship So ends these 24 hours
Lat 39.34 Long

Tuesday April 27th

Calm good weather. Saw Whales.
Saw one & chased all hands employed stowing down
at 6 AM made sail Middle part - thick
Latter part strong wind from S. & thick saw
Whales Sounded chase at 10 hours
Lat 39.50 Long 132.00

Wednesday April 28th

Calm strong wind from
S. saw Whales all hands employed in stowing down
Middle part strong wind from S. & thick
at 5 AM made sail stow down
Saw one whale going fast So ends

Thursday April 29th

Calm good weather
Saw one ship no Whales at 6 AM took
in sail Middle part calm at 5
AM made sail Saw Whales Sounded
& chased 3 ships in sight So ends

Friday April 30th

Calm strong wind from
Eastward saw Whales. Spoke the Mogul. Sounded
at 7 AM took in sail Spoke the Lion fairman
Middle part good weather at 5 AM made
sail Saw Whales Sounded & chased 2 ships
in sight saw Whales going fast So ends

Monday May 1st 1851.

Calm good weather saw Whales
Sounded & chased Middle part good weather at
5 AM made sail Saw Whales Sounded & chased
4 ships in sight So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday May 2nd

Calm strong wind from S.W.
Steering E.S.E. Saw Whales Sounded struck one & sunk
one sail in sight steering E.S.E. Middle part
strong wind steering E.S.E. under all sail
Latter part good weather saw 7, nothing so much

Lat 40.32 Long

Wednesday May 3rd

Calm good weather steering E.S.E.
under all sail all hands employed in mending
sails Middle part good weather steering East
one the wind Latter part fine breeze from
Northward steering on the wind under all sail

Lat 40.38 Long

Thursday May 4th

Calm fine breeze from
Northward steering Eastward on the wind under
all sail saw one whale spoke the Benj. Tucker
& Whales Middle part good weather at 5 AM made
the land Latter part light wind steering on the wind
for the Shialts of Sangai in company with the Benj.
Tucker saw one whale So ends these 24 hours

Lat 40.40 Long

Friday May 5th

Calm fine breeze from N.W. steering
for the Shialts in company with the Benj. Tucker
Middle part light wind & calms made in for
the Shialts Latter part calms Shialts in sight
10 o'clock So ends
