Monday May 6th 1850

Came fine breezes from
Western steering N.E. in for the Straits of
Langar in company with the Benj. Tucker
at 5th P.M. entered the mouth of the Straits
middle part light winds from S.W. steering N.E. East
at 6 o'clock got out of the Straits latter part
calms. Land in sight Saw herpet. back. to land

Lat 44° 45' Long 143° 45'

Tuesday May 7th

Came light winds from S.W.
steering Eastward under all sail in company
with the Benj. Tucker. Land in sight
middle part light winds from S.W. steering E.S.E.
under all sail latter part thick & calms

Lat 44° 16' Long 143° 40'

Wednesday May 8th

Came light winds from Southern
steering Eastward in company with the Benj.
Tucker. Middle part strong winds from
Southern steering East. Latter part strong winds
from S.W. steering E.E. under all sail to land.
{Maine fell down}

Lat 42° 18' Long 146° 00'

Thursday May 9th

Came strong winds from S.W.
steering N.E. under all sail in company with
the Benj. Tucker. Middle part strong winds & rain
steering N.E. under double reefed sails. Latter
part quick & rainy steering N.E. by E. under
reef topsails in company with the Benj. Tucker

Friday May 10th 1850

Came strong winds from S.W. thick
& rainy steering N.E. under reefed sails in company
with the Benj. Tucker. Middle part strong winds
from S.W. & rainy. Latter part thick & rainy steering
N.E. under close reefed sails in company with the Benj. Tucker

Lat 45° 30' Long 157° 20'

Saturday May 11th

Came strong winds from S.W. steering
N.E. under close reefed sails in company with the Benj. Tucker
Middle part the same. Latter part strong winds
from S.W. steering N.E. saw fire back. to land

Lat 46° 48' Long 154° 31'

Sunday May 12th

Came light winds from Southern
steering N.E. under all sail Benj. Tucker out of sight
Middle part thick steering N.E. under reefed sails
Latter part thick & rainy steering N.E. to land. Noobs

Lat 48° 20' Long 156° 40'

Monday May 13th

Came strong winds from Southern thick
& rainy steering N.E. under close reefed sails. Middle
part thick. Latter part light winds from S.W. thick
& rainy. Spoke the Benj. Tucker saw one sail to land

Lat 49° 20' Long 157° 40'

Tuesday May 14th

Came light winds from S.W. steering
N.E. under all sail in company with the Benj. Tucker
one sail in sight. Middle part thick. Latter
part strong winds from S.E. thick & rainy steering
N.E. by E. under double reefed sails in company with
the Benj. Tucker saw one ship steering N.E. to land
