Thursday June 13th 1850

Came good thick snow ships
V. the Landall hands employed Boiling
Middle part thick & strong winds from SE.
Latter part the same lineated Boiling spoke
the Triton & in Boiling nothing saw 11 ships to end

Lat 63.12.

Friday June 14th

Came strong winds from
SE. Steaming & 11 under double reef sail spoke
the ship Semad & 11 under V. Boiling 3 Whales
all hands employed in Boiling lower Middle
part strong winds and thick latter part the
same saw Whales & 3 ships to end.

Lat 63.35.

Saturday June 15th

Came strong winds from
SW saw Whales 11 under 1 got one took him
alongside spoke the ship Liverpool & 11 under
14 Whales. Middle part strong winds latter
part strong winds employed in Boiling 14 ships
in sight to end. these 24 ships

Lat 63.10

Sunday June 16th

Came strong winds from SE
saw fin birds and ships all hands employed
in Boiling Middle part good weather
latter part calms all hands employed Boiling

Lat 63.18. Lat 63.18

Monday June 17th

Came light winds & calms saw
ships & plenty & one whale all hands employed
in Boiling Middle part good weather 10 P.M.
took a dead whale alongside & cut him in
latter part strong winds from SW thick &
raining employed in Boiling to end 24 ships
saw in sight

Cruising in Lat 64.00

Tuesday June 18th 1850

Came strong winds from SW thick &
raining all hands employed in Boiling Middle part
strong winds & raining going too cool lower latter
part thick & employed in Boiling & standing to end
24 ships

Wednesday June 19th

Came strong winds from Southern
thick & raining spoke the ship Rockaway & 11 under
6 ship. Middle part strong winds thick & raining latter
part the same employed in Boiling & in 24 ships

Thursday June 20th

Came strong winds from Southern
thick & raining employed Boiling 5 ships in sight at 6 P.M.
finished Boiling Middle part thick & strong weather
latter part good weather Steaming SW under all sail
saw one whale going fast. Employed throwing down
Lat 64.19.

Friday June 21st

Came good weather Steaming SW
saw one whale going fast & 8 ships in sight
Middle part strong winds from Southern thick & raining
spoke the Back Norton 7 Whales latter thick to end
24 ships

Saturday June 22nd

Came strong winds from South
spoke the ship Columbus fantom 3 Whales
saw 2 ships Boiling Middle part good
weather spoke the Venus & 11 under 13 ships
latter part calms saw Whales 11 under
got one & sunk one to end there 24 ships
