Sunday June 23rd 1831.

Calm good weather all hands
employed cutting saw Whales found struck
drained Middle part calms latter part
calms saw Whales plenty found &
got one & cut him in so end

Monday June 24

Calm calms saw Whales
all hands employed in boiling 15 ships
in sight Middle part calms latter part
the same saw Whales got one cut him
in Land in sight 18 ships so end

Lat 64.03

Tuesday June 25th

Calm calms employed
cutting & boiling Land in sight Middle
& latter part calms employed in
boiling & stowing saw Whales so end

Lat 63.57

Wednesday June 26th

Calm calms 20 ships
in sight all boiling &c. Middle part calm
saw Whales Land & shore latter part the same
Land in sight 20 ships so end Lat 63.48

Thursday June 27th

Calm calms Middle
part calms Land in sight spoke the
USSA: employed stowing down boiling
latter part calms saw Whales found
& chased employed stowing down so end

Lat 64.15

Cruising in Lat 64° 00' Long about 178° 00' West
Friday June 28th 1831

Calm light winds saw Whales
found & got one took him alongside corner
cutting Land in sight Middle part Middle
part calms latter part good weather saw plenty
of Whales & ships Land in sight employed in cutting
Lat 64.27

Saturday June 29th

Calm good weather saw Whales found
& got one cut him in Middle part thick strong
winds & thick latter part good weather saw
Whales plenty Land in sight so end so end

Sunday June 30th

Calm good weather saw Whales plenty
all hands employed in boiling & stowing down
Land in sight Middle part good weather at 8 did
saw ice. latter part strong winds from Southward
& thick & rainy employed in stowing down so end so end

Monday July 1st

Calm strong winds from Southward
thick & rainy saw plenty of ice at 2 PM cooled down
more ship headed the North under close reef mainsail
& Rigging part thick & rainy 12 calm boiling
latter part strong winds from N.W. & rainy so end so end

Tuesday July 2nd

Calm strong winds from N.W. &
& rainy saw Whales plenty all hands employed
boiling Middle part thick & rainy cooled down
latter part thick & rainy saw 2 ships all landed
employed in stowing down saw one Whale so end
so end
