

Cruising in Lat. 64.31

Sunday July 14th 1830

Commenced calm & thick all hands employed in cutting 4 ships in sight. Middle part thick & employed boiling. Latter part thick & raining saw Whales got one & let him in so ended day

Monday July 15th

Commenced thick & rainy all hands employed in cutting spoke the Bark Cherokee 12 Whales saw 5 ships Middle part rainy. Latter part good weather all hands employed in stowing down & boiling spoke the Larkins to end Lat 64.31

Tuesday July 16th

Commenced good weather saw ships and no Whales saw in sight all hands employed in boiling & stowing down Middle & Latter part good weather to end Lat 64.30

Wednesday July 17th

Commenced thick saw Whales spoke the Charles Drew 7 Whales all hands employed in boiling & stowing down Middle & Latter part thick saw one ship to end Lat 64.30

Thursday July 18th

Commenced thick employed in boiling & stowing down saw nothing Middle part thick & employed in boiling. Latter part strong wind and thick stowing to end Lat 64.37

Friday July 19th

Commenced strong wind & thick at 7 P.M. finished sailing. Middle part strong wind from Eastward thick & rainy. Latter part strong wind and thick employed in stowing down saw the line & one ship to end

Cruising in Lat. 64.30

Saturday July 20th 1830

Commenced strong gale from Eastward & thick. Latter part strong wind & thick lying to. Latter part thick saw one ship to end these 24 hours Lat 64.47

Sunday July 21st

Commenced strong wind from Eastward steering on the wind under topsails saw nothing Middle part thick & rainy. Latter part the same saw 2 ships & humpbacks to end these 24 hours Lat 64.48

Monday July 22nd

Commenced thick & rainy saw one Whale landed & chased. Middle part thick & rainy made 8 P.M. Latter part thick & rainy. Scoured got 45 fathoms of water saw nothing to end Lat 63.44

Tuesday July 23rd

Commenced thick saw nothing Middle part thick Latter part good weather steering N.E. all hands employed in stowing down to end Lat 63.40 Long 116.30

Wednesday July 24th

Commenced good weather saw 11 Whales landed & got one 6 ships in sight. Middle part thick & rainy. Latter part thick & rainy all hands employed in cutting. Spoke the Charles Drew 9 Whales to end Lat 63.40

Thursday July 25th

Commenced strong wind & thick & rainy saw Whales & 4 ships in sight. Middle & Latter part thick & rainy saw Whales landed & chased all hands employed in boiling 4 ships in sight to end Spoke the Genl. Tucker 20.00 Lat 64.16
