Thursday Sept 5<sup>th</sup> 1850

Comm. light wind & calm sailing  
steering on the wind Middle part light wind from  
SE steering on the wind latter part light wind  
from Southward steering Eastward on the wind saw one  
ship steering the same. So ended these 24 hours  
Lat 35.72 Long

Friday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>

Comm. light wind from NE  
steering east one ship in sight all hands employed  
in search of one Middle part light wind  
from SE & calm spoke the ship Logan & New  
Bedford 1000 lbs latter part calm so ended these 24 hours  
Lat 35.73

Saturday Sept 7<sup>th</sup>

Comm. light wind from SE  
& calm steering on the wind in company  
with the Logan Middle part calm latter  
part light wind from SE 2 ships in sight so ended  
Lat 34.50

Sunday Sept 8<sup>th</sup>

Comm. light wind from SE  
steering on the wind Middle part  
Squally & raining steering on the wind so ended  
Lat 34.25 Long

Monday Sept 9<sup>th</sup>

Comm. light wind from SE  
steering on the wind one ship in sight Middle  
part light wind from SE steering on the  
wind 1000 lbs under all sail latter part  
the same 2 ships in sight so ended these 24 hours  
Lat 33.24 Long

Tuesday Sept 10<sup>th</sup> 1850

Comm. light wind from SE steering  
on the wind 2 ships in sight Middle part  
line breeze from SE & SE steering on the wind 1000 lbs  
latter part the same so ended these 24 hours  
Lat 31.30 Long

Wednesday Sept 11<sup>th</sup>

Comm. fine wind from Eastward & squally  
steering N by E & SE on the wind Middle part Squally  
latter strong wind from Eastward & squally so ended  
Lat 29.24 Long

Thursday Sept 12<sup>th</sup>

Comm. strong wind from Eastward &  
Squally steering N by E on the wind under reefed sail  
Middle part strong wind from ENE steering SSE under  
reefed sail latter part light wind from Eastward  
Lat 27.18 Long 15.47

Friday Sept 13<sup>th</sup>

Comm. light wind from Eastward  
steering on the wind under all sail Middle part  
Squally steering on the wind latter part strong wind  
from SE & squally steering N by E & SE so ended these 24 hours  
Lat 27.02

Saturday Sept 14<sup>th</sup>

Comm. strong wind from ENE  
steering N by E & SE on the wind under all sail Middle  
part light wind from SE steering SSE under all  
sail latter part Squally some rain so ended  
Lat 24.30 Long 15.44
