Sat 22nd Aug 1850

Monday Sept 16th

Some fine breeze to fine with steering South under all sail at 7 P.M. Made the Sandwich Islands. Steering in for Moore under all sail. Middle part fine breeze from Eastward steering down by Curbyke at 2 A.M. come too & stood of Fuller part good weather steering for Waahoo under all sail 2 ships in sight to end then 2 ships

Tuesday Sept 17th

Some fine breeze from ENE. Steering Westward for Waahoo in company with the Foghorn at 2 P.M. made Waahoo. Middle part good weather lying off or on at day light stood on at 10 o'clock took 4 Blot and went in come too at 12 in 4 fathoms of water to end

Wednesday Sept 18th

Some good weather lying at anchor one boat on shore. Middle & latter part good weather lying at anchor in Waahoo S. side

Thursday Sept 19th

Some good weather lying at anchor one boat on shore. Middle & latter part the same lying at anchor to end
