Middle part strong gale from West wind
heavy squalls at 12 some too heavy
Southward under close reef main topsail Latter
part heavy squalls & very heavy swell on S.E. end
to 6

Sunday Dec 1

Common strong gale from N.W.
Lying to under close reef main topsail & very
heavy swell on wind squalls & rain
Middle part the same Latter part strong Gale
from Westward steering East under double
reef topsails to end then at 4 hours Middle

Monday Dec 2

Common strong wind from N.W.
thick & rainy steering East & heavy swell on
Middle & Latter part light wind from S.W.
thick & rainy to end then at 4 hours to 6

Tuesday Dec 3

Common light wind from West
steering East under all sail Middle part
the same Latter part light wind from
Southward steering Eastward under all sail
All hands employed in coopersing oil to end

Common light wind from Southward
steering Eastward under all sail all hands employed
in coopersing oil Middle part light wind from
Southward steering Eastward under all sail Latter part

Thursday Dec 5

Common strong wind from S.W. steering
On the wind under close reef topsails Middle part
light wind from S.W. steering S.E. under all sail
Latter part strong wind from S.W. steering S.E.
on the wind under double reef topsails to end
Lat 44 15 Long 127 30

Friday Dec 6

Common strong wind from S.W. steering S.E.
On the wind under double reef topsails Middle part strong
Gale from Southward Lying to under close reef main topsails
Latter part the same to end then at 24 hours
Lat 43 33 Long 125 40

Saturday Dec 7

Common strong gale from Southward
Lying to headle Eastward under close reef main topsail
& reef fore sail Middle part the same Latter part
strong wind from S.W. steering E by S under reef
topsails to end then at 24 hours
Lat 43 39 Long 124 30

Sunday Dec 8

Common strong wind from S.W.
steering East under all sail Middle part
strong wind from Westward steering Eastward under
all sail Latter part strong wind & squally steering
East bent a new fore topsail to end then at 24 hrs
Lat 44 16 Long 118 00
