Westward. Ends with strong gales at N. W. Ships
head to the South and East have nothing
Thurs. 20th Sept 26. 27. S. Long 35. 31

Strong gales at S.W. Ship head to the S. and
East. Only Moderate Trade. Sail and Steered S.W.
Sine Vattering Employed in this Duty
at 24 Nov 14 10 East

Strong Winds at Santa Monica, N.V.
At Sun set took in sail heading to
the Castor and Ends. Underway employed in
coopering Sparrow and Bottomwood Boats.

Thursday the 1st of June 1837

 in the open hold. Breeze calm. ~~the~~ ^{the} wind
 in sight. Bearing West Dist 20 Leagues

Moderate winds at 8 & 8. Morning per S. Bago Bay
 Went to the best former stop and did
 At San Jac took in Seal heading for
 The Land At Day Light took Seal and
 Stopped in Shore at 4. Hunted this Seal in the
 Whale But saw nothing At 12. came on.
 Board and to End of the

Tuesday 6th First Boat Moderate sent in two boats
But found nothing At their next came on Board
And stood off shore Middle and latter part
Strong winds at Cat. B. camping all possible
Sail off shore the ship Mary in sight
