

Ship Falcon cruising off Delago Bay June 1859

Wednesday 7th

Strong wind at S E steering off shore by the
Wind At 2 P.M. steered for the land sent in
two boats without success at seven set sails
One boat and steered by the wind off shore
At day light sent in the two boats struck
and killed one whale and began towing him to
the ship and so ends No Wks

Thursday 8th

Moderate Employed in towing the whale to
the ship at 4 P.M. took him alongside and
began cutting and finished at 8 P.M. sent
Employed in bailing the cooper setting up hoops
At 11 P.M. took gear on board and steered up the
Bay sent ships crossing lower & W

Friday 9th

Moderate Employed in bailing Linnings & and
at 11 P.M. the ship & ships in sight
Ends Moderate sent one water hauled and
struck and at 1 P.M. sent 20 fathoms line
No Wks

Saturday 10th

Moderate At 4 P.M. finished bailing
at seven set sail to anchor at day
light got under weigh and sent two boats
without success and so ends No Wks

Sunday 11th

Moderate the boats in shore whaling
without success later part employed in
storing down No Wks

Monday 12th

Moderate Employed in storing down at 4 P.M. lowered
in whale without success At 8 P.M. the ship being struck
a whale and got some capt. Baker picked them up
and killed with capt. Linn and one other struck the
whale and took her along side of the ship
and so ends No Wks

Tuesday 13th

Moderate lowered and went in shore for
whales without success the ship keeps
Employed in storing down and so ends
No Wks

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Wednesday 14th

Moderate sent two boats in shore the many two
struck and killed one whale and took her
to the Falcon At 11 P.M. began bailing and
so ends No Wks



Thursday 15th

Moderate Wind off shore Employed in cutting
At 2 P.M. finished and sent two boats in shore
without success the ship keeps Employed
in bailing ends Moderate sent one whale
without success and so ends No Wks

Friday 16th

First part Moderate Employed in bailing
boats in shore whaling without success
ends with strong wind to the southward
Employed Moderate till off shore
At 4 P.M. finished bailing later part
Employed in getting ready for storing down
and so ends No Wks

Saturday 17th

Strong wind to the southward steering off
off shore Employed in storing down
at seven set sail Moderate steered for the land
2 hours and hauled back ends with strong
wind and squally weather Employed in storing
down and so ends No Wks

Sunday 18th

Light wind and calms At 4 P.M. came to
anchor in 9 fathoms sandy bottom
At day light got under weigh and sent
two boats in for whales without success

Monday 19th

Moderate sent two boats in for whales
without success and so ends
