The oil in the lower hold and so ends

Saturday 30th

Moderate Employed in coopersing the oil between
Decks at 5 o'clock the captain started for Napier-bogue
and so ends

Sunday 31st

Moderate the people on shore for silent
at 9 am the captain arrived from Napier-bogue
Saw two hump backs down the Bay and so ends

Monday 1st

Moderate Employed in getting the boat ready
for whaling and washing ship and clothes
Saw nothing and so ends

Tuesday August the 1st

Moderate at day light sent two boats up
the Bay for whales but saw nothing and so ends

Wednesday 2nd

Moderate two boats up the Bay for whales the
boat employed in getting ready for whaling
Saw nothing and so ends

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Thursday 3rd

Moderate arrived ship North America of
Hilmington 1200 lbs Employed in painting and
so ends

Friday 4th

Moderate Employed in painting ship and
getting wood and filling holes and so ends

Saturday 5th

Moderate Employed in getting wood and water
went up the Bay saw one whale but so tall
did not try to strike
Arrived in the Bay ship Kometon
Saturday of 1857

Sunday 6th

Moderate Wind and fine weather two boats up
the Bay but saw nothing and so ends

Monday 7th

Moderate Wind and fine weather two boats up the Bay
but saw nothing Employed in cutting wood and
filling water and so ends

Tuesday 8th

Moderate Wind and fine weather Employed in ship's
duty and so ends

Wednesday 9th

Moderate Wind and fine weather two boats up
the Bay for whales but saw nothing latter part
Employed in ship's duty and so ends

Thursday 10th

Moderate Wind and fine weather Employed in setting up
the rigging and so ends
