

Ship Falcon for the Augustine Bay Sept 1857

Monday 11th of Sept 1857

First part Moderate Middle and latter part Strong
Winds at South at 4 P.M. saw the land bearing East
& Squared Dist at 5 P.M. ship off shore
At Day light was ship in shore heading E 3/4 S
And so on till by 11 20, 24 Long 42.13 East

Tuesday 12th

Strong Winds at south Steering by the Wind to
the Eastward at 2 P.M. saw the Landward Island
bearing South East Steered in for the Bay at
4 P.M. came to anchor in 3 fathoms Water
Sent sick. bearing South toward the Ship Mass
At anchor 14 Balls Spearer latter part Employed in
Stowing down in the after hold and to End

Wednesday 13th

Moderate employed in ships Duties and so on
Mr. Butler failing every Day Dred every
thing that was possible for him and so on
With no success

Thursday 14th

Moderate Employed in Stowing down Water
Between Docks arrived Barque Speculation
Of Lisbon capt Robinson and so on
No Balls no better

Friday 15th

Moderate Employed in getting ready for sea
No Balls failing nearly fast Between the hours
Of 12 and 1 he Died made a coffin Went on shore
And dug a grave at 6 Buried him the

Captains of the two ships in the Bay Speculation
And Mass sent And Officers their kind
Assistance at the Funeral

Saturday 16th

Moderate at day light took our anchor and
Sailed out of the bay in company with the
Speculation Employed in Stowing the Anchors
And getting ready for Making

Sunday 17th

Moderate saw whales lowered in company
With the Speculation without Success
Lat 25.18 Long 48.20 East

Monday 18th

Moderate Employed in chasing Whales
Streak and the moon came out fast
The Whale latter part employed in
Ships Duties and so on

Lat 25.08 South Long 48.18 East

Tuesday 19th

Moderate Winds at South Steering to the
Westward Ends Moderate Employed in chasing
Tone top sail Lat 25.24 Long 48.30 East

Wednesday 20th

Moderate Winds and fine Weather Employed
In chasing Tone sail and so on

Lat 26.04 Long 48.28

Thursday 21st

Moderate Steering to the South Employed in
chasing sail and so on

Lat 26.20 Long 48.20 East

Friday 22nd

Light airs and calm heading to the Southward
Employed in chasing sail and so on

Lat 26.32 Long 48.21 East

Saturday 23rd

Strong Winds at South Steering by to
the Eastward at 6 P.M. were ship to the
Southward Employed in chasing sail and
so on

Lat by 16.52 Lat Long 48.30 East
