Monday 25th

Moderate winds at East steering by to the Southward
Ends & Ends Lat 27 07. South Long 43.40 East

Tuesday 26th

Light winds and calms heading to the S W
Employed in ships Duty and so ends

Lat 27.25 South Long 42.12 East

Wednesday 27th

Strong winds at South steering by to the
Eastward at 2 Am. took ship to the
Westward and so ends

Lat 27.34 Long 42.28 East

Thursday 28th

Moderate winds at S E steering by to
the S W. Later part wind at East steering
S E Employed in heading their Spencer
Saw nothing and so ends

Lat 31.25 South Long 42.30 East

Friday 29th

Moderate winds at E S E steering S W
At 8 Am. saw black fish. Saw and took it
to the ship and so ends No Obs

Saturday 30th

Moderate and fine weather steering S E but
Employed in sailing the Blackfish

Lat 33.09 South Long 46.09 East

Right Whales Oct. 1837

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Sunday 1st

Strong winds at S steering E S E
Saw nothing but fish and
Lat 33.34 Long 49.20 East

Monday 2nd

Strong winds at North steering S E S E
No Obs

Tuesday 3rd

Strong winds at N W steering S E S E
Ends Moderate Employed in ships Duty
No Obs

Wednesday 4th

Moderate steering E S E Ends with strong
gales at N W No Obs

Thursday 5th

Strong gales at West steering E S E
At 1 Am. took in sail and there too
At 3 Am. made sail and steered E S E

Lat 33.37 Long 50.20 East

Friday 6th

Strong gales at S W steering E S E

Saw right whales but did not lower

Ends More Moderate steering S W
At seen set took in sail Lat 33.37 Long 51.00

Saturday 7th

Strong winds at West steering West
Ends Moderate saw nothing Employed in ships
Duty Lat 34.04 South Long 60.00 East

Sunday 8th

Moderate with some rain steering S E S E
At 11 saw a dead whale and steered
for him and so ends
