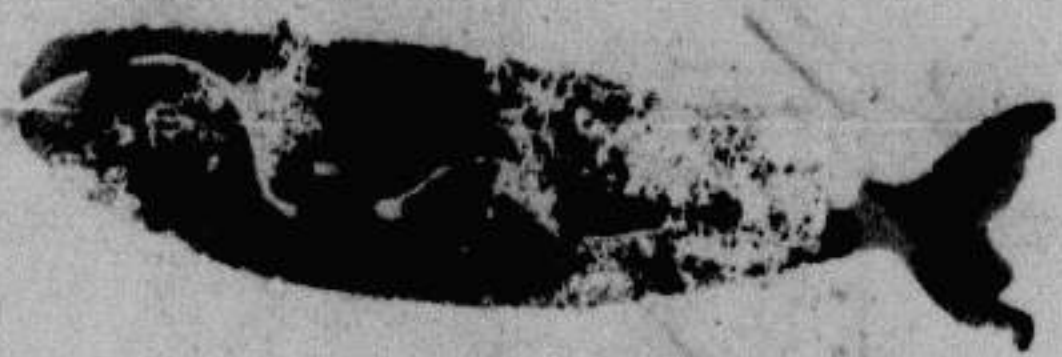


Ship Falcon cruising for Right
Monday Oct 9th 1837

Moderate Winds and fine weather Steering
for the whale at 8 took him to the ship
And cut him in commenced boiling and
let the back at 6 am finished
Saw 2 Whales and killers latter
Strong Strong gales and do Ends



Tuesday 10th Lat 34.54 Long 62 20
Strong gales at NW Ends Moderate
Employed in stowing down
Saw Nothing

Lat 34.29 Long 63.20 East

Wednesday 11th

Moderate Employed in stowing down
Saw Nothing Lat 34.28 Long 63.40

Thursday 12th

Strong Winds at N Steering to the Eastward
At 5 am Spoke Ship Delmon off N B 4 Whales
Ends with Moderate gales Saw Nothing
Lat 33.09 Long 64 48 East

Friday 13th

Strong gales at N heading to the Eastward
Saw the same Saw Nothing

Lat 34.38 Long 65 10 East

Saturday 14th

Strong gales at SW heading to the South and East
Ends in little more Moderate Saw one
Ship back but Nothing near the ship
At boiling considerably Lat 34.38 Long 66.20 East

Sunday 15th

Strong gales at South Ship's head to the Eastward
At 2 am have ship to the Westward at 4 am
Saw the West boat Ends Moderate took in
the Styer boat and set out another
One ship in sight

Lat 34.28 South Long 66 40 East

Whale in the Indian Ocean Oct 1837
Monday 16th

Moderate Spoke Ship Portland of Scarborough & Whales
Saw Whales lowered without success
Ends Moderate 7 Ships in sight do do

Tuesday 17th

Saw Whales lowered and took one to the ship
Began cutting took head throat and legs
And half of the body true out and
lost the rest Ends Moderate Employed in
Boiling Lat 34.14 Long 67 20 East



Wednesday 18th

Strong Winds at East saw Whales lowered
Without success Ends with moderate gales
At East at 6 am finished Boiling do do

Thursday 19th

Moderate gales at East heading to the North
A 5 am do do

Friday 20th

Strong Winds at East heading to the North
At 12 am made sail Saw one whale
Lowered without success Spoke Ship America
one of Wilmington 1400 Bbls Sold him one Boat
And bought one cask of Bread Employed in
stowing down and do ends Lat 33.08 Long 66.39

Saturday 21th

Strong Winds at NW Steering to the North
Employed in stowing down at 4 am
Finished and cleared the Deck
Spoke the South America capt Loe of
Wilmington with 1400 Bbls Latter part
More Moderate steering to the North and East
Saw Nothing and do Ends

Lat 34 46 South Long 66 40 East
