Sunday 19<sup>th</sup>

Moderate winds at SE Steering to the Westward  
Ship's gear returned at 22:00 Ship  
Part of forenoon 600 Balls Ends Moderate  
Sounded for Whales without success

Lat 34 56 Long 66 20 East

Monday 20<sup>th</sup>

Moderate S.W. Winds lowered and sunk one  
Struck one whale and cut off and let him go  
to sweep again and took one to the ship and so Ends  
No Whales



Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup>

Moderate Employed in cutting at 5.  
Finished and cleared the Deck latter part Moderate  
gales at NW Ship's head to the SW at 11 Began Drilling  
and so Ends Lat 34 56 Long 66 13 East

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup>

Moderate Steering to the North Employed in Drilling  
Ends the same Lat 34 59 Long 66 10 East

Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup>

Strong Winds at West Employed in Drilling  
Saw Whales lowered and sunk one latter part  
Strong Winds and rugged weather at 9 finished  
Drilling saw Whales gaining quick did not lower  
got two boats stave

Strong Winds at NW and rugged Employed

Ends with thick fog and rain saw nothing

South and West saw Whales lowered without success  
latter part Employed in straining Down  
Dispatched to the West

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>

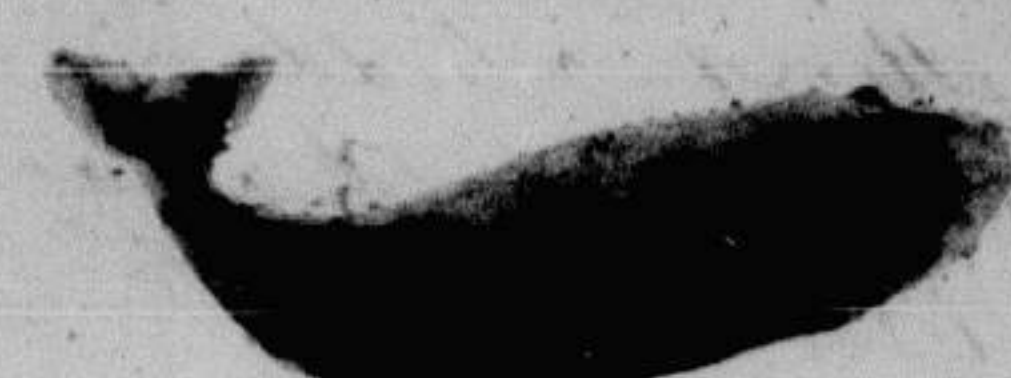
Moderate gales at West Ship's head to the North  
Ends with strong gales with some rain saw nothing  
Lat 34 11 Long 64 18 East

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>

Strong gales at West Ship's head to the North  
Ends more Moderate saw Whales lowered  
and sunk one and so Ends Lat 33 50 Long 64 20

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup>

Strong Winds at NW and rugged weather  
Steering by to the South and West saw Whales  
lowered and took one to the ship and  
began cutting and so Ends  
Lat 34 13 Long 63 00 East



Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup>

Light Winds and fine weather Employed in  
cutting at 4 finished and cleared the Deck  
latter part Moderate saw Whales lowered and took one  
to the ship which makes all that the Falcon can  
take Lat 35 32 Long 65 20 East

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup>

Moderate Employed in cutting  
at 4 finished and began Drilling  
Ends Moderate Employed in straining Down
