Thursday 28th

Light winds at SW steering by to the Westward
At 6 AM took a breeze from the SE squared
The yards and set the Studding sail latter part
Strong winds at East steering WSW Employed in mending sails
And to Ende lat 30.41 Long 30.41 East

Friday 29th

Strong winds at East steering W by S Employed
In Ships Duty carried away the fore topmast
Studding sail boom lat 21.50 Long 28.40 East

Saturday 30th

Moderate winds at SW steering by to the Westward
Latter part Squally carried away the flying jib
Boom carpenter Employed in making another one
People Employed in Ships Duty and to Ende
Lat 23.50 Long 27.01 East

Sunday 31st

Light winds at South steering WSW Ende with
Moderate winds at SE steering West
Lat 23.15 Long 23.00 East

Monday Jan 1st 1828

Moderate winds at SE steering WSW Employed in
Mending sail lat 23.30 Long 24.00 East

Tuesday 2nd

Moderate winds and fine weather Employed in mending
Sail andundry other jobs lat 23.54 Long 22.55 East

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Wednesday 3rd

First part Moderate winds at West steering by
to the Northward at 6 AM Wind Shift to the South
Ends with Moderate gales at NW sailing to the South
Employed in mending sails lat 26 Long 21.40

Thursday 4th

Moderate gales at NW ships head to the Southward
And to Ende Employed in mending sails
Lat 26.15 Long 21.30 East

Friday 5th

Strong gales at NW and Squally throughout
Employed mending sails ships head to the South and W
Lat 26.40 Long 20.55 East

Saturday 6th

Strong gales at NW ships head to the South and West
At 4 PM Wind veered to the Westward wore ship
And headed NW Ends more Moderate Made some sail
Lat 26.36 Long 20.50 East

Sunday 7th

Moderate winds at West steering by the wind on both tacks
Spoke Ship Emerald of Salem Capt. Coates 1500 Bbls.
Ends Moderate 3 Ships in sight lat 25.15 Long 19.29 East

Monday 8th

Moderate winds at West steering by on both tacks 3 Ships in sight
Ends the same Employed in Ships Duty and to Ende
Lat by lat 25.20 Long 19.59 West

Tuesday 9th

First part strong winds at West Ends with strong
winds at South South steering NWW one ship in sight
Employed in mending sails and to Ende
Lat 24.40 Long 19.40 East

Wednesday 10th

Strong winds at South steering NWW
Ends with Moderate gales at SE Employed in mending
Sizen Top sail
Lat 22.45 Long 18.29 East
