Wednesday 7th

Strong winds at N by N Steering N by N at
Sun set tack in light sails and Jib tacked
The top sails made sail in the morning Ends 40
Light airs and calms with some rain Lat 23.15 Long 42.50

Thursday 8th

Light airs and calms with some rain Working along shore
General sail in light at sunset tack in light sails
At day light made sail No Obs the land Dist about 8 leagues

Friday 9th

Light airs and calms heading along
Shore Saw General Sails Steering the same way
At sun set the land Dist about 4 leagues
Under moderate working along shore Spoke a Portuguese
Brig but got old name and 20 Cords

Saturday 10th

Moderate Steering in for the harbor at 10 let go
Our anchor the Word coming a head and dit tacked
Of it at 8 AM took over anchor and sailed up the Bay
At 12 came to anchor in 15 fathoms Soft Bottom
At 4 finished with the custom house officers and the
Captain went on shore

Sunday 11th

Fine weather all hands on shore 2
On Liberty at sun set all came off excepting 2
Ends moderate Steered the Windward Sailed 1000 lbs
Anchor 1000 lbs 1000 lbs 1000 lbs 1000 lbs
of Oil

Moderate fine weather on Watch on shore on Liberty
The Watch on Board Employed Repairing and Painting Ship

Tuesday 13th

Moderate on Watch on shore on Liberty
At sun set came on Board the Watch

Ship Strived Ship a number of Ship harbor & Banks
Cut 550 Mals oil and 120 Spexer
