Wednesday 25th

Strong breezes at East attended with
Snow and hail steered by the wind to the
Northward at 2 P.M. saw Long Island
bearing from N E 8 to N W at 5 P.M.
Tacked ship to the Southward Ends the
same Lat 40.27 North Long

Thursday 26th

Light airs at N W steering By to the Northward
At 4 P.M. took a breeze from the Southward
Squared the yards set the Studding sails and
steered N E 8 spoke brig Hannah & Abigail
Of Cranberry Isle at 9 P.M. saw Harlow
Light bearing North and steered N E 8

At Sun rise took a Pilot At 10.30
saw into the Harbor and No Ends
