P.M. light and pleasant breeze from
N.W. steering E by S with all sail set
at 8 A.M. the breeze falls nearly to a calm
middle part the breeze light and baffling
latter light breeze from N.W. and a heavy
swell on the watch employed in Ship Duty
Sat obs 39 54⁰⁰
Long by Chron 51:45

Friday July 31st P.M. light airs and fine
weather from the westward steering E by S
at 8 kept E by S 4/5 the wind eants to S.W.
and breezes on sum middle the weather
much the same

Sat obs 40 06⁰⁰
Long by Chron 48:45 W

Saturday Aug 1st 1846 P.M. light breeze
and fine weather from S westward steering
E & S by compass the watch employed in
Ship Duty latter part employed in bilking
a potato penw

Sat obs 40 05⁰⁰
Long by Chron 45:25 W

Sunday Aug 2nd P.M. light breeze and
fine weather from S westward steering
S & E by S the watch employed variously
latter A.M. light breeze and pleasant
weather from the westward

Sat obs 39 38⁰⁰
Long by Chron 43:39 W

Monday Aug 3rd 1846

P.M. the weather continues much the
same at raised a choal of sperm
Whales at 11-50 lowered and chaired
but who should not come up with them
what a petty they war gayne like the S
came on board and kept away S & E by E & E
and set studding sails the sails in sight
to the eastward latter A.M. light breeze
and frequent showers of rain

Sat obs 39 29⁰⁰
Long by Chron 41:24 W

Tuesday Aug 4th P.M. light breeze
and pleasant weather from the west
steering E & E a Ship and Chooner
in sight steering to the eastward
at 7 kept the Ship E by S 4/5 middle
part sum squalls of rain latter fresh
breeze and fine weather

Sat obs 39 57⁰⁰
Long by Chron 38:12 W

Wednesday Aug 5th P.M. fine weather
from the westward steering E by S 4/5 by
compass nothing in sight middle part
fresh breeze and sun squally the watch
employed in Ship Duty at 1 A.M. kept
E & E

Sat obs 39 54⁰⁰
Long by Chron 34:14 W
