and latter parts the weather much the
same

Friday Aug 21st P.M. the weather the
same steering S 4 W by compass at 11 one
sail in sight ahead middle and latter
part fresh breeze and flying clouds from
S.E. the watch employed in Ship Duty

Sat obs 22 4608
Long by chron 27 00 W

Saturday Aug 22nd P.M. fresh breeze and
flying clouds from S.E. steering S 4 W
by compass the watch employed in
Ship Duty at 7 A.M. kept the Ship
S by compass latter part fresh breeze
and flying clouds from S.E.

Sat obs 19-5108
Long by chron 26-31 W

Sunday Aug 23rd P.M. fresh breeze and
and flying clouds from S.E. steering S
saw a Brigh standing S.E. at 11 one sail in
sight ahead at 8 P.M. kept the Ship S by W
at 5 A.M. kept S latter part the breeze
the same two sails in sight of the lee
beam

Sat obs 17-1508
Long by chron 26-10 W

Monday Aug 24th 1846

P.M. the breeze more moderate steering the same
one of the last mention sails in sight
hailed sharp on the wind S eastward and
past astern of us about one mile off at 7
an other part us standing to the westward
latter part fresh breeze from the eastward
took in studding sail and braist sharp up
one sail in sight a head

Sat obs 14-5608
Long by chron 25-33 W

Tuesday Aug 25th P.M. the breeze more
moderate and can'ts to S.E. the above mention
sail in sight ahead middle and latter part
light baffling winds and frequent showers of
rain

Sat obs 13-4008
Long est 25-10 W

Wednesday Aug 26th P.M. calm and squalls
of rain and wind from difrents parts the
two above mention sails in sight to the
westward at 8 A.M. lowered for Blackfish
but without success came on board and
exchanged signals with a Dutch Ship two
other sails in sight

Sat obs 13-0708
Long by chron 25-45 W

Thursday Aug 27th at 4 P.M. the breeze
falls to a calm 4 sails in sight middle
the weather the same at 7 A.M. 5 sails in
sight at 8 Mr Wood ^{came on board} from the Ship Milo
and i went on board of the Milo latter calm
and frequent showers of rain

Sat est 12-5508
Long est 25-50 W
