

Thursday Sept 3rd 1876
P.M. the wind came to S.W. at 4 Brigs in sight of the weather. Bow fresh breeze and cloudy steering by S tacks aboard at 8 A.M. tacked to the N.W. three sails in sight two of them to the leeward standing to the eastward and one of them standing to the westward latter fresh breeze and flying clouds from the south. Sat obs 5:47.8
Long by chron 19:07.7

Friday Sept 4th P.M. the weather much the same steering by S tacks aboard one sail in sight to the windward middle and latter part light breeze and fine weather from S by W. Sat obs 5:10.0
Long by chron 20:18.7

Saturday Sept 5th P.M. tack ship to the S.E. light breeze and fine weather from S at 8 nearly calm middle and latter part light breeze and flying clouds from S.W. by S steering by S tacks aboard Sat obs 4:56.0
Long by chron 19:30.7

Sunday Sept 6th P.M. light airs and sun showers of rain from S westward steering by S tacks aboard middle and latter part fresh breeze and flying clouds from S.W. at 11 lowered for Blackfish but 2 Sat obs 4:25.0
Long est 18:00.7

Monday Sept 7th 1876
P.M. fresh breezes and flying clouds from S.W. steering by S tacks aboard middle part saw a sail standing to the westward at 8 A.M. tacked to the S westward latter part light breeze and fine weather from S by W steering by S tacks aboard Sat obs 3:54.8
Long by chron 16:45.7

Tuesday Sept 8th P.M. the breeze from S.W. steering by S tacks aboard at 7 nearly calm at 12 M took a light air from N.W. steering by S tacks aboard Sat obs 3:22.0
Long by chron 16:40.7

Wednesday Sept 9th P.M. the weather continued the same steering by S tacks aboard where air and have been hear for bout a week and his hard telling when we shall get out middle part the weather the same at 6 two sails in sight standing to the westward at 7 A.M. low wind for Blackfish and chased till 12 the breeze from S.W. Sat obs 2:48.0
Long by chron 16:24.7

Thursday Sept 10th P.M. the breeze continues the same steering by S tacks aboard at 2 lowered for Blackfish but at 4 three sails in sight standing to the westward middle and latter part fresh breeze and flying clouds from S steering by S tacks aboard and our Bark of the S quarter two miles distant standing the same Sat obs 2:03.0
