P.M. the weather the same lying under double reefed main top sail and fore sail heading to the Southwest at 2 saw a B whale at 10 wore to the eastward at 3 A.M. wore to Southwest light airs and hazy from the eastward

Friday Nov 13th P.M. set all sail and kept the ship W by S light airs and hazy from the eastward at 7 luffed to heading to the north and double reefed the top sails nearly calm and thick fog the cooper employed in setting up shooks at daylight set all sail 8 A.M. tacked to the eastward latter the wind came to the westward and thick fog

Saturday Nov 14th P.M. light breeze and cloudy from the westward kept S.E. at 2 raised B whale lowered and chased but without success came on board and kept S.E. at 7 took sail and luffed to the wind heading to the Southwest at daylight set double reefed top sails and at 8 kept S.E. saw an English Ship standing eastward all hands employed in starting water and slowed Down

Sunday November 15th 1846

P.M. fresh breeze and a heavy swell on from south steering E at 7 double reefed the top sails at daylight set all sail latter calm

Monday Nov 16th P.M. light airs from N eastward steering by S tacks aboard at 7 double reefed the top sails daylight set all sail fresh breeze from north at 10 A.M. raised B whale lowered and killed him at 12 got him long side

Sat obs 35.42 S
Long by Chron 63.10 E

Tuesday Nov 17th P.M. commence cutting at 3 got him in at 7 commence bailing and shortened sail blowing fresh from from N.E. heading to the eastward at 4 A.M. the wind came to S.W. wore ship to S eastward at 9 set double reefed top sails at 10 raised B whale gayne set whale top sails latter fresh breeze and flying clouds from S.W. employed in bailing

Wednesday Nov 18th P.M. fresh breeze from S.E. steering by S tacks aboard all hands employed in bailing 7 shortened sail middle part light breeze at 5 A.M. set all sail at 7 closed on fresh double reefed the top sails
