PM fresh breeze and flying clouds from  
from Eastward steering by S tacks  
aboard at 5 finished faling middle &  
latter part fresh breeze and fine weather  
from Eastward all hands employed  
in starting fresh water

Long est 65:30.8

Friday Nov 20<sup>th</sup> PM fresh breeze from  
Eastward steering by S tacks aboard  
all hands employed in stowing down oil  
in the main hatch at 7 set whale top  
sails the breeze fresh from Eastward  
tack ship to the south

Sat obs 33:47.9  
Long by Chron 65:21.8

Saturday Nov 21<sup>st</sup> PM fresh breeze from  
Eastward steering by S tacks aboard  
at 7 shortened sail to double reefed top  
& at 5 set all sail one sail in sight  
to the north of us saw whales and lowered  
twice but without success

Sat obs 34:34.9  
Long by Chron 65:20.8

Sunday Nov 22<sup>d</sup> PM fresh breeze from  
the eastward steering by on diprents tacks  
at 4:30 struck a whale at 7 cut from him  
came on board and shortened sail at 8  
AM lowered and darted but did not get  
fast at 10 lowered again but but but

Sat 34:48.9  
Long by Chron 65:00.8

Monday November 23 1876  
PM light breeze and fine weather from  
north lowered three times for whales  
but without success middle and latter  
parts thick lowy weather steering by  
on diprents tacks Sat obs 34:48.9  
Long by Chron 64:47.8

Tuesday Nov 24<sup>th</sup> at 2 PM kept of  
SE light breeze and thick fogg sunset  
shortened sail 7 AM saw a whale a quarter  
of mile from the ship a dead calm  
and thick fogg latter the same

Sat est 34:55.9  
Long est 65:00.8

Wednesday Nov 25<sup>th</sup> 8 PM thick fogg and  
calm at 8 AM took alight breeze from SE  
and the fogg lifted up set all sail and eased  
away mizzen top sail yard sent it down and  
commence making an new one latter thick  
fogg again

Sat est 35:00.9  
Long est 65:15.8

Thursday Nov 26<sup>th</sup> at 2 PM a dead calm  
and thick fogg the watch employed in  
making ayard and repairing the mizzen  
top sail at 9 took slight breeze from  
Eastward steered by S tacks aboard at 5  
AM set all sail and raised three R whales  
lowered and chased till 9 but they went  
of latter light breeze and fine weather

Sat obs 34:53.9
