

Thursday February 4th 1847

light breeze and lowry from E eastward
at 10 the Ship Hlanabul of Sugarhar
went out so ends

Friday Feb 5th at 8 P.M. got under
way with a fine fresh breeze from
N.E. and spoke the Benjaminsucker
lying between the heads 7 ments out
5 whales at 7 shortened sail fresh breeze
from E eastward Akroa heads baring
N.W. Dist 10 miles middle and latter
part light breeze and lowry from
S westward

Sat est 44-20
Long est 175-10.8

Saturday Feb 6th P.M. light breeze and
lowry from S westward steering by S tacks
aboard at 4 the breeze falls nearly to a calm
7 shortened sail at 10 took light breeze
from S eastward at 2 wore ship to S westward
8 A.M. wore to the eastward latter fresh
breeze and lowry no all

Sunday Feb 7th P.M. lited up sun set
Feb and main sail at 7 took them in
and wore to S westward at 8 M the wind
cants to S.W. wore to S eastward at 7 lowered
for Blackfish but without success
at 8 comes on fresh gale from S.W.
double reefed the top sails and wore to
S east Banks peninsula in sight
baring W.S.W.

Monday February 8th 1847

P.M. took in fore top sail at 6 took in
fore sail and mizzen top sail blowing a
fresh gale from S.W. middle part more
moderate at 8 A.M. set all sail and
wore to the westward latter light breeze
and fine weather from the south on bent
fore top mast staysail and repaired it

Sat obs 44:05 S
Long by Chron 175-38.8
Long by lunar obs 175-44.8

Tuesday Feb 9th P.M. nearly calm and
fine weather the watch employed in
bending fore top mast staysail and
fitting on new Boat at 5 took light
breeze from the south kept S by W
peninsula in sight to the westward at 7
double reefed the top sails light breeze
and fine weather at daylight set all
sail and kept S.W. at 9 lowered for
Blackfish but without success latter
light breeze and fine weather

Sat obs 44:46 S
Long by Chron 175:30.8

Wednesday Feb 10th P.M. the breeze continues
light and fine weather steering S.W. at 7
took in fore and mizzen top sails 5 A.M.
set whole top sails latter light breeze
and lowry from the north steering S.W.

Thursday Feb 11th P.M. luffed to heading
E.S.E. light breeze and lowry from north
middle the breeze cants to the westward
7 A.M. comes on fresh gale from S.W. took
in all sail but close reef main top sail
