

Sunday February 28th 1847

P.M. the gale continues fresh from W.G.W. lying under close reef main top sail and staysails at 7 more moderate set the fore sail heading to the south middle part. the wind came to the E. eastward and come on fresh gale & rain at 7 A.M. kept away W by S & S latter more moderate and the wind came to E.W.

Monday March 1st 1847

P.M. the breeze falls nearly to a calm set fore and mizzen top sails at 2 took a fresh gale from S.W. took in fore top sail heading to the S eastward middle part rain at 2 A.M. comes on fresh gale from S.W. at 5 took in fore sail and close reefed main top sail and wore ship to S eastward latter fresh breeze and squally and a heavy swell on Sat. obs 46:26 S

Tuesday March 2nd P.M. light breeze and all thundering swell on from the westward lying under short sail at 5 A.M. set all sail light breeze from the E.W. heading to the westward latter the weather continues the same

Wednesday March 3rd 1847

P.M. the breeze came to the south and cloudy weather wore ship to the westward at 7 double reefed fore and main top sails light breeze and a heavy swell on from south at 8 kept W.G.W. at 11 luffed to the wind latter fresh breeze and lowry from south one sail in sight ahead Sat. obs 46:42

Thursday March 4th P.M. the wind came to S.W. and clear of fine weather set jib and main sail steering by S tacks aboard the above mention sail in sight at 7 shortened sail moderate gale and frequent squalls from S.W. wore ship to S eastward Cape Sanders in sight to the E westward at 12 W. wore ship to the westward at 5 set jib and main sail fresh breeze from E.W. at 9 wore to S westward at 11 the wind came back to W.G.W. and comes on fresh gale took in sail & latter her drip saw two scraggs the land in sight Sat. obs 46:05

Friday March 5th P.M. blowing fresh gale from S.W. lying under short sail S tacks aboard the land in sight to the westward middle part more moderate at 5 A.M. set double reefed top sails and wore ship to E.W. at 10 tacked to S & set all sail light breeze and all thundering swell on from the westward
