P.M. lowered and sunk a whale at 3
spoke the Adeline Gills fresh gale and
lowing from S.W. double reefed the top
sails at 12 were ship S.W. at A.M. were to

Friday April 2nd 1847

P.M. more moderate and lowing from S.W.
steering by S tacks aboard at 5:30 were ship
to the S westward one sail in sight of the
lee quarter middle and latter part calm

N.E. kept N.W. at 6 shortened sail and luff
to heading N.E. W saw whale the above
mention sail turn in sight to the windward

Sunday April 4th P.M. light airs

and baffling at 2 raised whales and chaist
and darted at one but without success
at 6 double reefed the top sails the above
mention sail in sight at 12 were ship

darted twice and got slightly fast once
latter light breeze from S.E. eastward
