 at 6⁰⁰ P.M. kept of S light breeze and
 fine weather from E.S.E. at 4 raised whale
 at 5 lowered and chased without success
 at 6 double reefed the top sails & wore ship
 to N eastward the last mention sail in
 sight boiling at 2 A.M. wore ship to the
 south latter part light breeze and fine
 weather from the eastward lowered twice but
 without success
 Sat obs 45:22
 Long est 172:30-8

Wednesday April 7th at 3 P.M. lowered
 struck at 5 got him long side and shortened
 sail light breeze and flying clouds from
 the south at 7 A.M. commence cutting at 10
 got him in latter light breeze and cloudy from
 E.S.E. steered by S tacks aboard three sails in
 sight to the south
 Sat obs 45:06 P
 Long by Chron 172:33

Thursday April 8th at 2 P.M. wore ship
 to S westward and commenced boiling at 3
 thick heavy and nearly calm middle and
 latter parts calm employed in boiling two
 sails in sight
 Sat obs 45:00
 Long by Chron 172:47

Friday April 9th P.M. calm and fine
 weather employed in boiling the above mention
 sails in sight at 8 A.M. light breeze and
 fine weather from S.E.S.E. steering by S tacks
 aboard all hands employed in stowing
 down two sails in sight
 Sat obs 45:10
 Long by Chron 173:14 E.

Saturday April 10th 1847
 P.M. the weather continues the same all hands
 employed in stowing down at 3 wore ship to
 the S.W. three sails in sight saw the Hellingills
 take whale at 6 took in sail fresh breeze from
 N.E. at 12 wore ship to the eastward at 6 A.M.
 kept of S fresh gale from S.E.S.E. at 9 luffed to the
 wind all hands employed in stowing down
 Sat obs 45:22
 Long est 172:50

Sunday April 11th P.M. wore ship to the eastward
 and took in fore and mizzen top sails two sails
 in sight to the leeward at 1 the breeze falls away
 nearly to calm and rain at 9 wind came to the
 S.W. and comes on fresh gale took in fore sail
 latter fresh gale and fine weather one sail in
 sight
 Sat obs 45:24
 Long by Chron 173:45

Monday April 12th at 1 P.M. wore ship to the
 westward and set the fore sail at 6 set double
 reef top sails the above mention sails in
 sight to the windward at 8 A.M. wore ship
 to S.E. and set jib and main sail latter
 part fresh breeze from S.P.W. two sails in
 sight
 Sat est 45:15
 Long est 173:10 E

Tuesday April 13th P.M. fresh breeze and
 cloudy from S.P.W. at 1 wore ship to the
 westward at 5 took in jib and main sail
 three sails in sight at 1 A.M. wore ship
 to the westward & wore to S eastward latter
 fresh breeze and cloudy from S.P.E. three
 sails in sight
 Sat est 45:10
