

Wednesday April 14th 1847

P.M. the weather the same at 4 tacked to the eastward at 6 shortened sail and spoke the Ship
x Salem capt. Han Sagherber 30 ments out 1600 bls 100 of it sperm 4 other sails in sight middle and latter parts calm on bent main top sail and bent an other Sat obs 44:54

Thursday April 15th P.M. light breeze from N eastward kept S by E 4 E 5 sails in sight at 5 took in sail light breeze and cloudy from N E 12 hepped to to N westward at 7 A.M. raised whales lowered and struck and one Boat drawn and the other got the line cut by the iron and the whale went off Sat obs 45:22

Friday April 16th at 1 P.M. lowered and struck at 4 got him long side and commence cutting at 9 got him in and shortened sail light breeze and fine weather from north latter calm and foggy commence boiling Sat obs 45:14 S

Saturday April 17th P.M. took light breeze from the south set all sail and steered by S tacks aboard at 6 double reefed the top sails and wore Ship to the westward the watch employed in boiling at 2 A.M. wore Ship to S westward at 9 spoke the
x Ship Goodreturn New Bedford capt. Swept 32 ments out 5000 bls of oil 150 of it sperm latter fresh breeze and flying clouds Sat obs 45:50

Sunday April 18th 1847

P.M. saw whales gayne quick at 2 wore Ship to the westward 5 shortened sail nearly calm and afeary swell on at 10 finished bailing and wore Ship to the eastward latter calm all hands employed in stowing down 4 sails in sight Sat obs 45:26

Monday April 19th P.M. lowered and chast but without success took light breeze from N.W. steered by S tacks aboard at 7 double reefed the top sails the breeze came to S.W. and cloudy middle calm latter light breeze from north and a thunder swell on 4 sails in sight Sat obs 45:29

Tuesday April 20th P.M. comes on fresh gale double reefed the top sails at 6 took them in one Brig in sight and a number of whales at 12 wore Ship to the westward latter more moderate set whole top sails and steered by on different tacks two sails in sight Sat obs 45:32 S

Wednesday April 21th P.M. the weather the same steering by S tacks aboard at 6 took in sail nearly calm and cloudy at 2 A.M. the wind came to S.W. and blowes on fresh gale took in fore sail at 8 set it latter fresh and flying clouds Sat obs 45:22
