P.M. the weather much the same at 6 wore ship to the westward two sails in sight standing to the westward middle part light breeze at 2 A.M. wore ship to the eastward latter fresh breeze from north steering by 4 tacks aboard

Friday April 23rd P.M. the breeze the same at 6 shortened sail one sail in sight to the leeward at 12 the wind came to P.M. and blows on fresh at 2 wore ship to the westward at 9 wore to S.E. latter fresh gale two sails in sight

Saturday April 24th P.M. more moderate set 4th and main sail at 4 wore ship to the westward at 6 took in sail nearly calm at 10 took light breeze from S.W. kept south latter light breeze and fine weather two sails in sight

Sunday April 25th P.M. light breeze and pleasant weather from north steering S.P.W. at 6 shortened sail and kept N.W. middle fresh breeze at 10 luffed to with the main top sail aback at 8 A.M. set double reef top sails fresh gale from S.W.

P.M. the weather the same at 1 wore ship to the eastward 5:30 took in fore and mizzen top sails saw whale lapping at 1 A.M. wore ship to the westward latter part blowing fresh gale from S.W. wore ship to S.E. saw whales to rigged to lower Sat est 45:30

Tuesday April 27th blowing fresh gale from S.E. lying under double reef main top sail & fore sail at 2 A.M. wore ship to the westward latter part fresh gales set double reef top sail and set one sail in sight to the leeward

Sat. obs 45:41

Wednesday April 28th P.M. the weather continues the same at 2 wore ship to the eastward at 6 took in fore and mizzen top sails A.M. wore ship to S.W. latter more moderate set whole top sails

Sat. est 45:40

Thursday April 29th P.M. more moderate and rainy saw whales and lowered truss without success one sail in sight at 6 shortened sail nearly calm at 10 the wind came to the eastward and blows on fresh at 3 wore ship to the north 8 A.M. wore to the S eastward latter blowing fresh gales and rain
