8 AM light baffling winds at 4:30 took up wind and rain from S, E took in sail 7 sails in sight at 7 nearly calm at 10 the wind came to the north wore ship to the westward latter part light breeze and fine weather from NW, W three sails in sight and Banks of peninsula

Sunday May 9th 8 AM the weather continues fine at 4 tacked ship to E eastward and spoke the Barque Juno of Lydena capt Hays 6 months out 100 bl sperm at 5 shortened sail the land in sight to the westward middle part light baffling winds latter light breeze from E, S, E

Monday May 10th 8 AM gamb with the Achine Gibs and the Juno at 5 shortened sail the B Tucker in sight at 2 AM wore ship to the westward latter part light breeze and fine weather from north the land in sight to the westward 4 sails in sight

Tuesday May 11th 8 AM tacked ship to the eastward fresh breeze from E, S, E at 5 shortened sail and wore ship to the westward latter part light breeze from S, W three sails in sight

Wednesday May 12th 1847

8 AM the weather much the same steering by S tacks aboard at 4 wore ship to north and shortened sail one sail in sight and the land to the westward at 1 AM the wind came to the NW and comes on fresh gale took in fore sail latter the same heading to the south the B Tucker in sight

Thursday May 13th 8 AM wore ship to the westward the weather continues much the same lying under double reef main top sail and staysails at 10 wore ship to E eastward at 7 AM wore to the westward latter more moderate set whole top sails

Friday May 14th 8 AM light breeze and fine weather from S steering by S tacks aboard at 5 shortened sail middle in latter nearby calm

Saturday May 15th 8 AM light breeze from S, E kept W sent down fore sail and repaired it at 5 shortened sail the land in sight to the westward and Banks in sight to the north and two sails at 10 wore to the eastward latter fresh breeze from S, S, E
