P.M. bent the fore sail and double reefed the top sails fresh breeze from E, S, W at 3 wore ship to the eastward at 5 took in fore and mizzen top sails the Banks in sight and one sail to the leeward at 2 A.M. wore ship to the north at 6 set all sail and kept S, S, W light breeze from N eastward three sails in sight

Monday May 17<sup>th</sup> P.M. comes on fresh breeze and heavy from E, S, E luffed to to the wind I tacks aboard and double reefed the top sails at 2 wore ship to the north latter part light breeze and heavy one sail in sight to the leeward

Tuesday May 18<sup>th</sup> P.M. spoke the Ship Goodreturn and gamb. with her at 7 wore ship to S eastward light breeze and cloudy from the eastward at 12 M wore to north at 9 A.M. wore to S eastward latter fresh gale and thick heavy weather from north

Wednesday May 19<sup>th</sup> P.M. the weather continues the same at 5 wore to north 11 30 wore to south 8 A.M. wore to north latter part light breeze and thick foggy

Saturday May 22<sup>nd</sup> P.M. light breeze and pleasant weather from S, E at 4 spoke the B. Tucker Capt Sans 11 ments out 600 bls three other sails in sight at 4 A.M. wore to S, W & wore to the eastward latter fresh gale and heavy from S, E, E

Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup> P.M. the weather the same at 5:30 wore to S, W at 12 wore to the eastward at 8 A.M. wore to the westward latter fresh gale and a high sea on

Monday May 24<sup>th</sup> P.M. more moderate set whole top sails at 11:30 took in sail 12 wore ship to the eastward 10 A.M. the wind came to south and comes on fresh gale and rain took in fore sail

Tuesday May 25<sup>th</sup> P.M. the weather the same lying under double reef main top sail and stay sails heading to E, S, E at 5 A.M. comes on heavy gale and heavy squalls close reefed main top sail and turned up the Boats latter blowing a perfect storm one sail in sight ahead
