

Sunday June 27th 1847

P.M. the weather continues the same lying under close main top sail and fore sail at 8 A.M. wore ship to S.E. & W. latter the gale increases Sat. obs 46:20 Long est 172:60

Monday June 28th P.M. the gale the same at 6 wore ship to S. eastward at 8 A.M. wore to S. westward at 11 set double reef top sails latter fresh gale and heavy from S.E. Sat. obs 46:30 Long by Chron 172:38

Tuesday June 29th P.M. the weather the same steering by stacks aboard under double reef top sails at 12 wore ship to the eastward at 1 A.M. wore to S.W. latter blowing as usual Sat. obs 45:56 Long by Chron 172:18

Wednesday June 30th at 5 P.M. wore ship to the eastward blowing grate gale from S.E. & W. steering by under double reef top sails at 2 wore ship to the S.W. and took in fore and mizzen top sails at 4 A.M. set them again latter fresh gale and heavy Sat. obs 45:47 Long est 171:50 E.

Thursday June July 1st 1847

P.M. wore ship to the eastward the weather the same at 2 A.M. wore ship to the north the wind came to the eastward latter light breeze and thick fog Sat. est 45:27 Long est 172:00 E

Friday July 2nd 1847

at 5 P.M. wore ship to S.E. light air and thick fog from the eastward at 2 A.M. wore ship to the S.W. at 4 the wind came to eastward wore to S.E. at 9 set whole top sails and main sail latter light air and cloudy Sat. obs 45:31 Long by Chron 172:30

Saturday July 3rd P.M. wore ship to the eastward light breeze and fine weather from S. at 5 double reefed the top sails middle and latter parts light breeze and fine weather from S.W. Sat. obs 45:16 Long by Chron 173:50

Sunday July 4th P.M. light breeze and fine weather from S.W. steering by stacks aboard at 5 double reefed the top sails the breeze fell nearly to a calm at 11 took light breeze from S. eastward kept S.W. at 7 set all sail latter thick and rain on obs

Monday July 5th P.M. wore ship to S.E. and took in main sail at 4:30 double reefed the top sails the weather thick and rainy from E at 10 the wind came to S.W. and came on fresh gale and rain took in fore and mizzen top sails and fore sail latter more moderate Sat. obs 44:57 Long est 173:30

Tuesday July 6th P.M. set the fore sail at 4 calm and a heavy swell on middle light baffling winds latter light breeze from S.W. set all sail steered by stacks aboard banks peninsula barind W.S.W. Dist 40 miles Sat. obs 44:16 Long by Chron 174:24 E
