Wednesday July 21st fine weather all hands
employed in Ship Duty

Thursday July 22nd fine weather all hands
employed in Ship Duty latter fine weather

Friday July 23rd at 4 P.M. comes
on fresh gale from N.E. & E latter employed
in getting water

Saturday July 24th P.M. fine weather
all hands employed in getting Wood and
water latter fresh gale

Sunday July 25th P.M. more moderate
middle and latter parts fine weather

Monday July 26th P.M. fine weather
latter part the weather continues fine

Tuesday July 27th P.M. fine weather
all hands employed in getting Wood
and water latter the same

Wednesday July 28th P.M. fine
weather employed in getting Wood and
water latter part the same

Thursday July 29th P.M. fresh breeze
from N.E. getting water latter heavy

Friday July 30th 1847
P.M. got underway and the breeze
fell to a calm at 2 came to Anchor latter part
calm and rainy

Saturday July 31st P.M. calm and
heavy latter part light breeze from E, N, E

Sunday August 1st 1847
P.M. light breeze from
E, N, E middle and latter part rain

Monday Aug 2nd P.M. the weather the
same middle and latter fresh breeze and rain
from south

Tuesday Aug 3rd P.M. calm and rain
middle part and latter calm

Wednesday Aug 4th P.M. calm and heavy
middle part fine weather latter heavy

Thursday Aug 5th P.M. at 3 got under-
way at 5 came to Anchor to the kike calm
and rainy latter blowing heavy from the eastward
Friday 6th

Saturday Aug 7th P.M. blowing heavy
and rain from the eastward middle and
latter part the weather the same

Sunday Aug 8th P.M. fresh gale
and rain from E, S, E latter calm

Monday Aug 9th P.M. calm and heavy
at 8 A.M. got underway with fresh breeze from
the north latter all hands employed in
stowing anchors and chains fresh breeze from
N.E. double reefed the top sails
