P.M. fresh breeze and fine weather from S.W. steering by S tacks aboard at 1 A.M. wore ship to the westward latter part light air and fine weather from the north the Peninsula bearing N.W. Dist 20 miles at 10:30 wore to the eastward

Wednesday Aug 11th P.M. moderate breeze from S.W. steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set on bent the new main sail and bent the old one middle and latter parts fresh breeze and clearing from S.E.

Thursday Aug 12th P.M. fresh breeze and heavy from S.E. steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set at 8 wore ship to S westward middle calm and rain at 1 A.M. took fresh breeze from S.W. kept N by E 4/8 E and double reefed the top sails latter blowing fresh and fine weather

Friday Aug 13th P.M. fresh breeze and fine weather from S.W. kept N 4/8 E at 4 lett the reef cut fore top sail middle and latter parts brisk breeze and fine weather from W.S.W.

Saturday Aug 14th 1847

P.M. light breeze and fine weather from W.S.W. steering N.W. the watch employed in repairing main top G sail at 4 sent down fore top sail and bent on other at 7 kept N by E 4/8 E at 12 double reefed the top sails blowing heavy from the westward at A.M. took in fore and mizzen top sails and luffed to the wind at 11 kept away N by E latter fresh gale and flying clouds from S.W.

Sunday Aug 15th P.M. fresh gale from S.W. steering N by compass under double reef top sails at 7 kept N 4/8 E at 9 set all sail middle and latter part light breeze and fine weather from the south at 7 kept N by W

Monday Aug 16th P.M. light breeze and fine weather from the south steering N.W. at 6 shortened sail to double reef main top sail and fore sail at 8 luffed to the wind to the eastward at 1 A.M. the wind came to the northward at 6 set all sail latter fresh breeze and fine weather from S. the land in sight to the S.W.
