

Wednesday August 18th 1847

P.M. tacked ship to the eastward fresh breeze from S.S.E. at sunset took in fore and mizen top sails the wind from S at 12 wore ship to the westward at 6 A.M. set double reef top sails at 10 comes on heavy gale from S.W. wore ship to the eastward and took in all sail but double reef main top sail. Sand in sight to the westward

Thursday Aug 19th P.M. fresh gale from S.W. lying under double reef main top sail with 3 tacks aboard at 6 A.M. more moderate set double reef top sails and wore ship to the westward at 10 set all sail latter light breeze and a heavy swell on from S.W. steering by 3 tacks aboard. Sat. Obs 37:45

Friday Aug 20th P.M. light breeze and fine weather from S.W. at 4 the breeze falls to calm at 6 shortened sail light breeze from N.W. and a heavy swell on middle part the wind backing at 5 A.M. come on fresh gale from the westward took in fore sail the sand in sight to the westward latter the weather the same lying 3 tacks aboard

Saturday Aug 21st P.M. the weather continues the same lying under double reef main top sail middle and latter part calm and fine weather. Sat. Obs 37:27 P

Sunday August 22nd 1847

P.M. light airs from S.E. kept W by S sent down the fore sail and repaired it at 6 double reefed the top sails nearly calm middle part light breeze from the north latter fresh breeze steering by 3 tacks aboard. Sand in sight to the westward

Monday Aug 23rd P.M. fresh breeze from N.W. steering by 3 tacks aboard at 5 tacked ship to the N.E. eastward at shortened sail the sand Dist 2.5 miles at 1 A.M. wore ship to the westward the wind came to N at 6 set double reef top sails 4 main sail fresh gale from N.W. at 11 wore ship to the eastward and took in main sail

Sat. Obs 37:52

Tuesday Aug 24th P.M. fresh gale and heavy from N.W. steering by 3 tacks aboard at 6 took in all sail but close reef main top sail and staysails middle part blowing heavy at 9 saw a Brig standing to the westward latter part more moderate set the fore sail

Sat. Obs 38:38

Wednesday Aug 25th P.M. the wind came to the westward and more moderate and sun squally at 6 the gale comes on fresh again lying by 3 tacks aboard middle part the weather the same at 6 A.M. more moderate set double reef top sails at 10 the came to W.S.W. and come on heavy gale took in all sail but double reef main top sail and staysails
