Friday Aug 27<sup>th</sup> P.M. the gale continues  
the same by S tacks aboard  
middle and latter parts the same  
Sat obs 57:28

Saturday Aug 28<sup>th</sup> P.M. the gale the  
same by S tacks aboard middle  
and latter parts little more moderate  
Sat obs 57:00  
Song by Chron 178:36

Sunday Aug 29<sup>th</sup> P.M. the gale  
abated sun and came to the S.E.  
bying under double reef main top  
sail and staysails S tacks aboard  
middle part more moderate at 6 set whole  
top sails latter light breeze from S.E.  
Sat obs 56:49

Monday Aug 30<sup>th</sup> P.M. light breeze  
from S.E. steering by S tacks aboard  
at 6 took in fore and mizzen top sails  
middle part light breeze from the east  
at 6 A.M. set double reef top sails  
blowing fresh from S.E. at 11 come on  
fresh gale and lowy took in fore  
and mizzen top sails Sat. est 57:30  
Song est 178:10

Tuesday August 31<sup>st</sup> 1847  
P.M. fresh gale and  
lowy from S.E. took in fore sail  
at 6 A.M. set double reef top sails latter fresh  
breeze and lowy from the S.E. Sat obs 58:00  
Song by Chron 179:05

Wednesday September 1<sup>st</sup> 1847  
P.M. kept S.W. with fresh  
breeze from S. sun lowy and a heavy swell on  
at 6 A.M. set all sail raised whole and set the  
sun of ~~me~~ him called it a humpster latter light  
and showing from the south heading to the  
westward  
Sat obs 57:05  
Song est 178:00

Thursday Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> P.M. light breeze  
and cloudy from the south steering by  
S tacks aboard at 6 shortened stail to  
a double reef main top sail and fore sail  
at 12 wore ship to the eastward at 6 A.M.  
set all sail and kept of S.W. light from  
S.E. at 10 lowered for Blackfish struck  
and drawed  
Sat obs 57:16

Friday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> P.M. light breeze  
and fine weather from S.E. steering  
N.W. by Compass with all sail set  
at 6 took in sail too double reef main  
top sail and fore sail middle light  
air from the south latter calm and fine  
weather
