Tuesday Sept 14th P.M. light breeze and
heavy from S.E. steering by Stacks
aboard under top sails and cores at 6 shortened
sail middle part fresh gale and rain at 12
wore ship to S. westward latter part heavy
gale from W.S.W. Sat. obs 31-39
Long by Chron 177-35 E

Wednesday Sept 15th P.M. blowing
heavy from W.S.W. bying to Stacks
aboard under double reef main top sail
and fore sail middle and latter parts the
weather continues the same Sat. obs 31-44
Long by Chron 178-03 E

Thursday Sept. 16th P.M. the weather
continues the same at 4 wore ship to
the westward bying under double reef main
top sail and fore sail at 6 A.M. set double
reef top sails latter fresh gale from S.W.
Sat. obs 31-44 E

Friday September 17th 1847
P.M. the weather continues
the same at 4 wore ship to the eastward at
6 took in fore and mizzen top sails middle and
latter parts the weather continues the same
Sat. obs 31-20

Saturday Sept 18th P.M. fresh gale
and a heavy swell on from S.E. steering
by Stacks aboard under double reef top
sails at 6 took them in latter part
fresh breeze from E steering by Stacks
Sat. obs 31-58.9

Sunday Sept 19th P.M. brisk
breeze from E steering Stacks aboard
at 6 shortened sail at 12 wore ship to the
E. eastward at 6 A.M. set all sail light breeze
and fine weather from E.S.E. Sat. obs 30-59
Long by Chron 178-35
Long by Lunar 178-49

Monday Sept. 20th P.M. light breeze
and fine weather from E.S.E. steering by
Stacks aboard at 6 shortened sail at 6 A.M.
set all sail at 9 raised a sail head latter
part light breeze and fine weather
Long by Chron 178-52 Sat. obs 31-26 E

Tuesday Sept. 21st P.M. light breeze
and fine weather from S.E. at 3 spoke the
B. Tucker and the Alpha of Nantucket
W. Capt. Folger 14 months out W. W. S. steam
and gamb with them latter part fresh breeze
and cloudy Sat. est 31-55 Long by est 177-10 E
