S.W. & E and low at 2 A.M. wore ship to  
the eastward latter part fresh gale and rain in  
torrents at 8 kept away S.W. at 11 the wind  
came to the westward and moderated sun  
Sat. est 32.08.9  
Long est 179.00.0

Thursday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> P.M. set top  
sails at 6 took in fore and mizzen top  
sails and luffed to blowing fresh from  
the westward middle and latter part fresh  
gale and cloudy from S.W. steering by with  
S. tacks aboard  
Sat. obs 33:15  
Long est 180.00

Friday Sept 24<sup>th</sup> P.M. the weather  
continues the same steering by S. tacks  
aboard with all sail set at 6 shortened  
sail at 6 set all sail fresh breeze from the  
south  
Sat. obs 34:01.9  
Long by Chron 178:11.7

Saturday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> P.M. fresh breeze  
from S.E. steering by S. tacks aboard at 6  
shortened sail at 6 set all sail nearby  
calm at 10 took fresh breeze from W.S. & W.  
kept S.E.  
Sat. obs 33-52.9  
Long by Chron 177-16.7

Sunday Sept 26<sup>th</sup> P.M. fresh breeze  
from W.S. & W. steering S.E. with all sail  
set at 6 shortened at 6 A.M. set all sail  
latter fresh breeze from the westward  
Sat. obs 35.09 Long by Chron 175.50.7

Monday September 27<sup>th</sup> 1847  
P.M. fresh breeze from W.S. & W.  
steering S.E. with all sail set at 6 shortened  
sail and luffed to to the north at 8 A.M. kept  
S.E. fresh gale from the westward Sat. obs 35:39.9  
Long by Chron 174:33.7

Tuesday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> P.M. kept S.E. by S.  
at 6 fresh gale and rain took in all sail  
but close reef main top sail and luffed to to  
the north middle and latter parts the weather  
continues the same  
Sat. obs 35:25  
Long by Chron 174-18

Wednesday Sept 29<sup>th</sup> P.M. the gale continues  
fresh lying under close reef main top sail with  
S. tacks aboard at 6 A.M. set all sail light  
breeze from S.E. at 8 wore ship to the eastward  
Sat. obs 35:15  
Long est 174.00.7

Thursday Sept 30<sup>th</sup> P.M. brisk  
breeze from S.E. steering by with all sail  
set S. tack aboard plenty of pinbacks in  
sight at 6 double reefed the top sails one  
sail in sight to the leeward at 5 A.M. wore ship  
to the south latter light breeze and cloudy from S.E.  
steering by S. tacks with all sail set  
Sat. est 35:50  
Long est 175-30

Friday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1847 P.M. light  
breeze and cloudy from E.S.E. steering by S.  
tacks with all sail set at 6 double reefed the  
top sails and wore to the north at 8 A.M.  
wore to S.E. latter fresh gale from S. east  
steering by S. tacks aboard under double  
reefed top sails and courses one sail in  
sight
