at 5 the wind came to N.W. wore ship
and set fore sail and kept one reef out
the main top sail at 6 A.M. set all sail
latter fresh breeze from the westward steering
by S tacks aboard

Alding 27 men's out 800 bl 550 of it sperm

Thursday Oct 6th P.M. light breeze and
fine weather from N.W. steering
S.E. in company with the Pacific at 6 double
the top sails and kept by the wind the
wind from N.E. W middle and latter parts
fresh gale and rainy from N.E. W steering by
under double reef top sail

Friday Oct 7th P.M. fresh gale and fine
weather from N.E. W kept away S at 6 took
in fore and mizzen top sails and luffed to to
the westward middle part fresh gale and squally
at 6 A.M. set double reef top sails latter light
breeze and small J. heavy swell on from
N. westward

Saturday Oct 8th P.M. fresh gale
and squally thunder and lightning and
a heavy swell on from the westward at
6 took in the top sails middle and latter
parts fresh gale and heavy squalls of rain
from N.E. W took in fore sail and set
main staysail
