P.M. the gale the same being under double reef main top sail and staysails. Stacks aboard at 7 wore ship to S. westward at 8 A.M. set double reef top sails and kept away N.E. fresh gale from S.W.

Monday Oct 11th P.M. kept E at 3:30 raised 5 R. whales lowered and chaised without success luffed to S tacks plenty of fin backs in sight at 2 A.M. wore ship to the S. eastward at 5:30 set whole top sails fresh gale from S.W. steered by S tacks aboard at 11 raised 5 R. whales lowered and chaised but without success

Tuesday Oct 12th P.M. fresh gale and a heavy swell on from S.W. at 4 wore ship to the westward at 5:30 lowered and chaised but but — came on board and double reefed the top sails at 1 A.M. wore ship to the westward at 5:30 set rib and main sail at 10 raised whales lowered and chaised but without success fresh gale from S.W. one Bark in sight Sat. Obs 35:35

Wednesday Oct 13th P.M. fresh gale from S.W. steering by on different tacks saw 2 whales gone quick to the windward the Bark in sight at 6 took in rib and main sail middle steered by on different tacks at 5 set all sail latter fresh breeze from the W. Sat. Obs 35:34

Thursday October 14th 1847

at 1 P.M. lowered and chaised a R. whale at 4 chaised another at 6:30 double reefed the top sails fresh gale from the westward the last mention bark in sight at 1 A.M. wore ship to south at 5 set rib and main sail at 10 wore to the north fresh gale from W.

Friday Oct 15th at 5 P.M. lowered and chaised whales at 4 lowered and chaised again but without success at 6:30 took in rib and main sail and wore to the north two sails in sight to the windward unwhaling fresh gale and cloudy from the westward at 2 A.M. wore ship to the south at 10 raised whales and chaised latter fresh breeze from the westward Sat. Obs 35:28

Saturday Oct 16th P.M. raised whales and chaised without success at 6:30 double reefed the top sails fresh breeze from N.E. W. the two above mention sails in sight at 2 A.M. wore ship to the north at 6 raised whales lowered and chaised without success latter blowing fresh gale from N.W. Sat. Obs 35:22

Sunday Oct 17th P.M. wore ship to the westward at 6:30 took in rib and main sail blowing fresh gale from N.W. and a heavy swell on two sails in sight to the leeward middle raising at 8 A.M. clear of fine weather raised whales lowered and chaised at 10 lowered and struck one and the line parted Sat. Obs 35:28 Song by Chron 170:50 W
