

Monday October 18th 1847

P.M. lowered and chaist whales three times but they air as wild as the D at 6:30 double reefed the top sails fresh gale from S.W. at 10 wore Ship to S westward at 5:30 set all sail at 6 raised whales lowered and chaist without success latter light breeze and fine weather from south one sail in sight Sat obs 35:21

Tuesday Oct 19th P.M. light breeze and fine weather from south lowered and chaist whales twice but at 6:30 double reefed the top sails 4 sails in sight at 1 A.M. the wind came to S.W. and came on fresh gale at 8 wore Ship to the westward latter fresh gale and heavy swell on top sails in sight one of them hailing Sat obs 35:22

Wednesday Oct 20th P.M. wore Ship to the S eastward fresh gale and a high sea on from south the two above mention sails in sight at 11 A.M. wore Ship to the westward at 6 A.M. set double reef top sails saw whales to ruged to lower latter fresh gale small thunder swell on from S.W. Sat obs 35:18

Thursday Oct 21st P.M. fresh gale from S.W. steering by S tacks under double reef top sails saw whales to ruged to lower two sails in sight on our weather beam at 11 wore Ship to the westward at 5 set all sail at 7 wore to the S eastward latter light breeze from south

Friday October 22nd 1847

P.M. light breeze from the south steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set saw one whale once but he vanished on bent main top sail and bent another at 6:30 double reefed the top sails one sail in sight on the weather quarter at 2 A.M. wore Ship to the westward at 5:30 set all sail light breeze from the north latter the weather the same saw whales lowered and chaist but without success Sat obs 35:31 S

Saturday Oct 23rd at 8 raised whales lowered and struck one took him long side at 8 got him in thick down from E.S.E. one sail in sight her Boats fast to whale at 1 wore Ship to the south at 6 raised whales lowered and chaist without success the B Tucker in sight cutting latter fresh breeze from S

Sunday Oct 24th P.M. struck two whales and drewed from boath spoke the B Tucker had got 3 whales at 6:30 double reefed the top sails fresh breeze from W.S.W. middle the breeze came to the westward and blowed on fresh gale and heavy at 5 A.M. wore Ship to the north latter fresh gale saw whales to ruged to lower the watch employed in hailing the B Tucker in sight
